

Queen presents Aidilfitri donation to 500 poor and hardcore poor recipients

KUALA LUMPUR: Her Majesty Raja Zarith Sofiah, Queen of Malaysia yesterday presented Aidilfitri donations to 500 recipients comprising the poor and hardcore poor from the federal capital.
