

# Dr Zaliha: More than RM1 mln allocated for prospective haj pilgrims in Federal Territories

**PUTRAJAYA:** The Federal Territories Department (JWP) has allocated cash contributions amounting to RM1.102 million to 2,204 prospective haj pilgrims in the Federal Territories of Kuala Lumpur, Putrajaya and Labuan, through the Ihsan@Puji initiative.

Minister in the Prime Minister's Department (Federal Territories) Dr Zaliha Mustafa said that each pilgrim would receive RM500 for their preparation for the pilgrimage.

"The cash donation will be channelled to the Kuala Lumpur City Hall, Putrajaya Corporation, and the Labuan Corporation, and will then be distributed to prospective haj pilgrims in the three territories," she said in a statement yesterday.
