CITY HALL is getting as much of the city as possible involved in this year's Federal Territory Day celebrations.

Thirty-one activities have been planned beginning Jan 21 to Feb 25 although City Day falls on Feb 1.

There are competitions a-plenty, exhibitions and treasure hunt — all with the emphasis on public participation and fun, fun, fun!

The first activity, which began on Jan 21 is an inter-flat competition. Forty flats in the city are taking part in the competition.

Gaily decorated flats will come alive at night with twinkling lights as the flats "battle" for the title. The prize-giving will be on February 18.

Currently on is the Bowling Gala which is being held at Federal Bowl. Organised by the FT Ten Pin Bowling Association, the contest

goes on until Feb 1.

As usual, there will be an orchid competition and exhibition for City Day. This year's event begins this Sunday and ends on Feb 1. Check out the colourful extravaganza at the Orchid Garden at Taman Tasik Perdana from 9am to 6pm.
