CITY HALL TO TAKE ACTION

Zaliha orders crackdown on KL parking touts

KUALA LUMPUR: Kuala Lumpur City Hall has been instructed to step up patrols and surveillance to stop parking touts.

Minister in the Prime Minister's Department (Federal Territories) Dr Zaliha Mustafa said stern action must be taken

against those involved in the illegal activity.

"Over the past few days, I have received many complaints about parking touts in Kuala Lumpur.

"I have instructed @DBKL2u to step up surveillance and patrols and crack down on such activ-

ities," she said in a post on X (formerly Twitter) yesterday.
