

Jalan Masjid India safe, Mayor assures

KUALA LUMPUR: Kuala Lumpur City Hall (DBKL) assures the entire area in Jalan Masjid India here is safe to visit and no stalls or buildings have been ordered to close operation.

Kuala Lumpur Mayor Datuk Seri Dr Maimunah Mohd Sharif said that currently the area that is closed with barriers only involves a path of about 200 metres from Wisma Yakin to the police hut to make way for rehabilitation and construction work at the location of the sinkhole incident.

“Throughout the incident, we did not (direct) any of the stalls to close, we only closed part of the area. People can still come and visit along the footpath.

“We have also met with the traders’ association in the Jalan Masjid India area yesterday and confirmed that the surrounding area is safe, and only the area cordoned off with barriers is closed,” she told Bernama after attending the opening of the Amboi festival at TRX Friday.
