UNLICENSED HAWKERS

STALLS OWNED BY FOREIGNERS SEIZED

Action by KL City Hall carried out in Medan Idaman, Gombak

NINE stalls believed to be owned by foreigners around Jalan Jernai 1 and Jernai 3 in Medan Idaman, Gombak, were seized by Kuala Lumpur City Hall on Saturday.

City Hall said the crackdown was carried out by its Enforcement Department in collaboration with the Wangsa Maju branch office.

It targeted foreign hawkers operating without licences.

“Nine seizures were carried out in accordance with the Licensir of Hawkers By-Laws (WPKL) 2016.

“The items have been transported to the Jalan Lombor storehouse in Taman Miharj Cheras, for record-keeping purposes and documentation,” said on Facebook.

The statement said that the authorities would continue to take action and monitor illegal hawker hotspots.
