

# Spruce up for Merdeka

**BUILDING-OWNERS** are urged to fly the Jalur Gemilang and spruce up their buildings in conjunction with Malaysia's 51st Independence Day celebration.

Kuala Lumpur mayor Datuk Ab Hakim Borhan said him to 150 owners of hotels, private firms and business premises.

"City Hall would like to have their support and co-operation to beautify the buildings around the city, including lighting up, just as in previous years, to create a celebratory mood," he said.

with us. Also present during the meeting was Mr. Kamariah Abdul Kadir, General Manager of Tenaga Nasional Berhad (TNB) Kuala Lumpur. She said TNB would continue giving special tariffs called *Insentif Sinaran Merdeka* to building-owners, just as in previous years, to show TNB's support.

"The promotional rate will be for August and September. We gave a rebate of RM1.4 million last year and of that, RM670,000 were for those in KL."

The celebration is from Aug 1 to Oct 18, and themed *Perpaduan Teras Kejayaan*.
