

# Ramadan stalls bids open

A TOTAL of 6,655 Ramadan bazaar lots are up for grabs in Kuala Lumpur this year.

City Hall has allocated the stalls for 11 parliamentary areas in the city.

There has been a reduction of 53 stalls from last year as City Hall has decided to not allow stalls to operate near Puduraya, stating that would lead to more congestion in the area.

Application forms for those interested will be made available from June 29 to July 1 at the Titiwangsa indoor stadium.

The draw for stall lots would be carried out in the presence of officers from the Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission to ensure transparency.

Mayor Datuk Ahmad Badar Ismail said City Hall was serious in wanting to ensure there would not be any lobbying by certain quarters in the allocation of stalls.

"We would also like to remind the people that we will not hesitate to revoke the licences of traders who sub-let their stalls to non-licensed traders."
