

# KL draft plan hearings to end this month

THE public hearing sessions of the Draft Kuala Lumpur City Plan 2020 are scheduled to be completed at the end of this month.

Mayor Datuk Ahmad Fuad Ismail said a report will then be prepared by the Public Consultation Hearing Committee (POHC) panel for submission to City Hall.

"We will look into the recommendations made by the POHC. After that, we will have discussions with our focus groups," Ahmad Fuad said.

"After taking into account all these

views, we will decide if there is a need to make any amendments to the draft."

The amended draft will then be presented to the Federal Territories Ministry. Ahmad Fuad said City Hall hoped the entire process could be finalised by the end of the year.

Once gazetted, the draft plan will act as the blueprint for development in the city until 2020. The plan was unveiled in May last year and had received more than 5,000 suggestions and objections from the public.
