

KL bazaar stall fees set at RM500

KUALA LUMPUR: The fee for each Ramadan bazaar stall under the Kuala Lumpur City Hall is set at a minimum of RM500, Minister in the Prime Minister's Department (Federal Territories) Dr Zaliha Mustafa said.

The charges include a RM200 deposit, which will be refunded to traders if they comply with licensing conditions.

"Traders only need to pay RM300 per lot at the Ramadan bazaar. This rate is considered reasonable and affordable, especially for small-scale traders.

"It is also lower compared with fees charged in some other areas, particularly those managed by private entities, as is still the case in several towns in other states," she said when winding up the debate on the motion of thanks on the royal address on behalf of the Prime Minister's Department in the Dewan Rakyat on Tuesday. – Bernama
