# Temple agrees to relocate to new site 50m away

**KUALA LUMPUR:** The Dewi Sri Pathrakaliamman temple has agreed to relocate to a nearby site, said Minister in the Prime Minister's Department (Federal Territories) Datuk Seri Dr Zaliha Mustafa.

She said the government had identified a 4,000 square feet site about 50m from the current location.

"The size of the new site is

equivalent to the existing temple area. It is part of Lot PT 95, Section 40, Mukim Bandar Kuala Lumpur.

"The development of the new site will comply with existing regulations, and the temple management has agreed to these conditions," she told a press conference here yesterday.
